	3.1	Course marks will be 5' or 6' orange cylindrical marks			
	3.2	Start & Finish marks will be orange spherical marks			
	3.3	New marks will be 5' or 6' orange cylindrical marks with a coloured flag			
4	Time Limits				
	4.1	Mark 1 time limit	15 minutes		
	4.2	Target race time	45 Minutes		
	4.3	Race time limit	60 minutes		
	4.4	Finishing window	To minimise excessive delays between races, the race committee may award a finishing position to slower boats that are still racing after the race time limit. This will be indicated by displaying flag 'W' from the Committee Boat. This changes Appendix S, 12.3		
5	Changes and Additions to RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions				
	4.2	Flag 'AP' will not be displayed ashore, this changes Appendix S, 4.2			
	4.3	When Flag 'B', with one sound signal, is displayed ashore no boat should launch. Boats already afloat should return to the shore. When Flag 'B' is flown over a class flag, or flags, the class, or classes, indicated should not launch or, if afloat, should return to the shore. Failure to comply may result in disqualification.			
	6.1	Contender Class flag – Flag 'G'. Snipe Class flag – Flag 'T'			
	7.1	Appendix S 7.1 will not apply.			
	7.2	Course diagrams will be displayed on the ONB			
	9.3	Flag 'F' will be displayed from the Committee Boat, before the first boat finishes, to indicate that another race will follow as soon as possible. The warning signal for the new start sequence will be made 1 minute after Flag 'F' is removed with one sound signal.			
	RRS Rule 42	RRS Rule 42 and Appendix P5 will apply to the Contender Class only in winds over 10 knots. This will be indicated by the Committee Boat.
