<b>1</b>	<b>Schedule of Races</b>			
1.1	Sunday	2 <sup>nd</sup> September 2018	Race 1	Warning signal not before 10.25
			Race 2	Back to back after race 1
			Race 3	Warning signal not before 13.55
			Race 4	Back to back after race 3
1.2	The latest time for a warning signal will be 15.25			
<b>2</b>	<b>Locations</b>			
2.1	The BSC Race Office is located at the seaward end of the shelter on the pier.			
2.2	The ONB is located in the Race Office and will be duplicated in the entrance to the Clubhouse.			
2.3	Signals made ashore will be made from the flag pole at the Race Office.			
<b>3</b>	<b>Marks of the Course</b>			
3.1	Course marks will be 5' or 6' orange cylindrical marks			
3.2	Start & Finish marks will be orange spherical marks			
3.3	New or replacement marks will be 5' or 6' orange cylindrical marks with a coloured flag			
<b>4</b>	<b>Time Limits</b>			
4.1	Mark 1 time limit	20 minutes		
4.2	Target race time	45 minutes		
4.3	Race time limit	15 minutes after the 1 <sup>st</sup> boat finishes		
<b>5</b>	<b>Changes and Additions to RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions</b>			
	4.2	Appendix S, 4.2 will not apply		
	4.3	When Flag 'B', with one sound signal, is displayed ashore no boat should launch. Boats already afloat should return to the shore. When Flag 'B' is flown over a class flag, or flags, the class, or classes, indicated should not launch or, if afloat, should return to the shore. Failure to comply may result in disqualification.		
	6.1	Class flag – Laser Class Flag		
	7.1	Appendix S 7.1 will not apply.		
	7.2	Course diagrams will be displayed on the ONB		
	9.2	The starting line will be between the orange mast, with 2 red triangles, at the Race Office and the course side of the outer distance mark.		
	9.3	To alert boats that a race, or sequence of races, will begin soon, multiple sound signals will be made no more than one minute before a warning signal is made.		
	9.4	For back to back races, the signal described in 9.3 will be made as soon as practicable after the end of the previous race.		
	11.1	The finishing line will be between the orange mast, with 2 red triangles, at the Race Office and the course side of the outer distance mark.
