Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, RYA Prescriptions, Class Association Rules and Broadstairs Sailing Club Sailing Instructions. The Exoneration Penalty (and the Advisory Hearing and RYA Arbitration) of the RYA Rules Dispute Procedures will be available. 'Competitors should note that 'Broadstairs Sailing Club' implement the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found at the front of the RYA rule book (Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020) or at www.rya.org.uk/racing/charter

The event is open to all members of EKYA Sailing and Yacht Clubs

Entries will be accepted on the day of the event

The entry fee for this event will be a personal donation to The Pilgrims Hospice (Thanet)

Registration will take place from 09.00 in the Clubhouse

Results will be determined using the RYA Low Points system

There will be 3 races back to back with 3 to count

1st warning signal for the dinghy fleet not before 10.55

Yachts will start 15 minutes before the dinghy fleet

Briefing 10.00 below the Race Office

The course(s) to be sailed will be displayed at the Race Office

Risk Statement

Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of sailing states "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone"

Sailing is by nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

(a)	They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;	(d)	Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
(b)	They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;	(e)	The provision of a Race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
(c)	They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;	(f)	The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;
		(g)	Their boat is adequately insured, with cover of at least £2,000,000 against third party claims;
