



# Amendment to the BSC Sailing Instructions 2021

Sailing Instruction 2 has been amended to allow individual fleet races to be shortened. The existing and amended Sailing Instruction 2 is shown below.

## Existing Sailing Instruction

- 2 Onshore Signals and Notices
  - 2.1 Any change to these sailing instructions will be posted at least 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the first race of the day.
  - 2.2 When Flag 'B', with one sound signal, is flown from the Squarehead, no boat is to launch. Boats already afloat should return to the shore. When Flag 'B' is flown over a class flag, or flags, the class, or classes, indicated should not launch or, if afloat, should return to the shore. Failure to comply may result in disqualification.
  - 2.3 The Class Flag for Handicap racing will be **Flag 'G'**. Any additional Class Flags will be posted on the Official Notice Board.

## Amended Sailing Instruction

- 2 **Onshore Signals and Notices**
  - 2.1 **Any change to these sailing instructions will be posted at least 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the first race of the day.**
  - 2.2 **When Flag 'B', with one sound signal, is flown from the Squarehead, no boat is to launch. Boats already afloat should return to the shore. Failure to comply may result in disqualification.**
  - 2.3 **Class Flags will be as follows;**

<b>Handicap Fleet</b>	<b>Flag 'G'</b>
<b>Gold Fleet</b>	<b>Numeral Pennant 1</b>
<b>Silver Fleet</b>	<b>Numeral Pennant 2</b>
<b>Bronze Fleet</b>	<b>Numeral Pennant 3</b>

**Any additional Class Flags will be posted on the Official Notice Board.**

**When a signal is displayed over a Class or Fleet flag(s), the signal applies only to the Class(es) or Fleet(s) indicated.**
