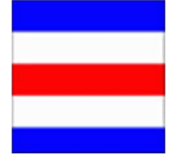

1 Schedule of Races				
1.1	Saturday	24 September 2022	Race 1	Warning signal not before 12.55
			Race 2	Back to back

1.2	The latest time for a warning signal on the last day of racing will be 14.00			
2 Locations				
2.1	The BSC Race Office is located at the seaward end of the shelter on the pier.			
2.2	The ONB is located in the Race Office and will be duplicated in the entrance to the Clubhouse.			
2.3	Signals made ashore will be made from the flag pole at the Race Office.			
3 Marks of the Course				
3.1	Course marks will be 5' or 6' orange cylindrical marks.			
3.2	Start & Finish marks will be orange spherical marks.			
3.3	Replacement marks will be black triangular marks.			
4 Time Limits				
4.1	Mark 1 time limit	There will be no Mark 1 time limit, but races may be abandoned and restarted at the discretion of the Race Officer		
4.2	Target race time	45 Minutes		
4.3	Race time limit	90 minutes		
4.4	Finishing window	To minimise excessive delays between races, at the discretion of the race committee they may award a finishing position to slower boats. This will be indicated by displaying flag 'W' from the Committee Boat. This changes Appendix S, 12.3		
5 Changes and Additions to RRS Appendix S - Standard Sailing Instructions				
	4.2	When Flag 'B', with one sound signal, is displayed ashore no boat should launch. Boats already afloat should return to the shore. Failure to comply may result in disqualification.		
	5.2	To alert boats that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, multiple sound signals will be made at least one minute before a warning signal is made. This changes Appendix S 5.2.		
	6.1	Contender Class flag – Flag 'T'		
	7.1	Appendix S 7.1 will not apply.		
	7.2	Course information and diagrams will be displayed on the ONB.		
RRS Rule 42	RRS Appendix P5 will apply in winds above 10knots. This will apply when boats pass a Boat displaying flag 'O' with repetitive sounds. Should the wind speed become less than 10knots, Rule 42 will apply when boats pass a boat displaying flag 'R' with repetitive sounds
